Job Description: The Adjunct Structural Fitting Instructor will facilitate classroom and hands on training of the skills and competencies needed to be a structural fitter or ship fitter. The Structural Fitting Instructor will provide instruction, assess, and document skill/knowledge attainment on the skills required to be a fitter including: industrial shop math, blueprint reading, fitting, welding, metal work/industrial safety practices, etc... This job description is not intended to be all inclusive and the employee will also perform other reasonably related duties. This position reports directly to the Workforce Training Coordinator.

Duties and Responsibilities: Teach specific modules on the skills and competencies for an entry level position as a structural/ship fitter. Teach courses at a variety of times, including evenings and weekends, mainly at the Woodville training location. Submit required Regional Workforce reports and forms. Develop and utilize a course syllabus for each course, following established Regional Workforce guidelines. Advise students in career and program matters.
